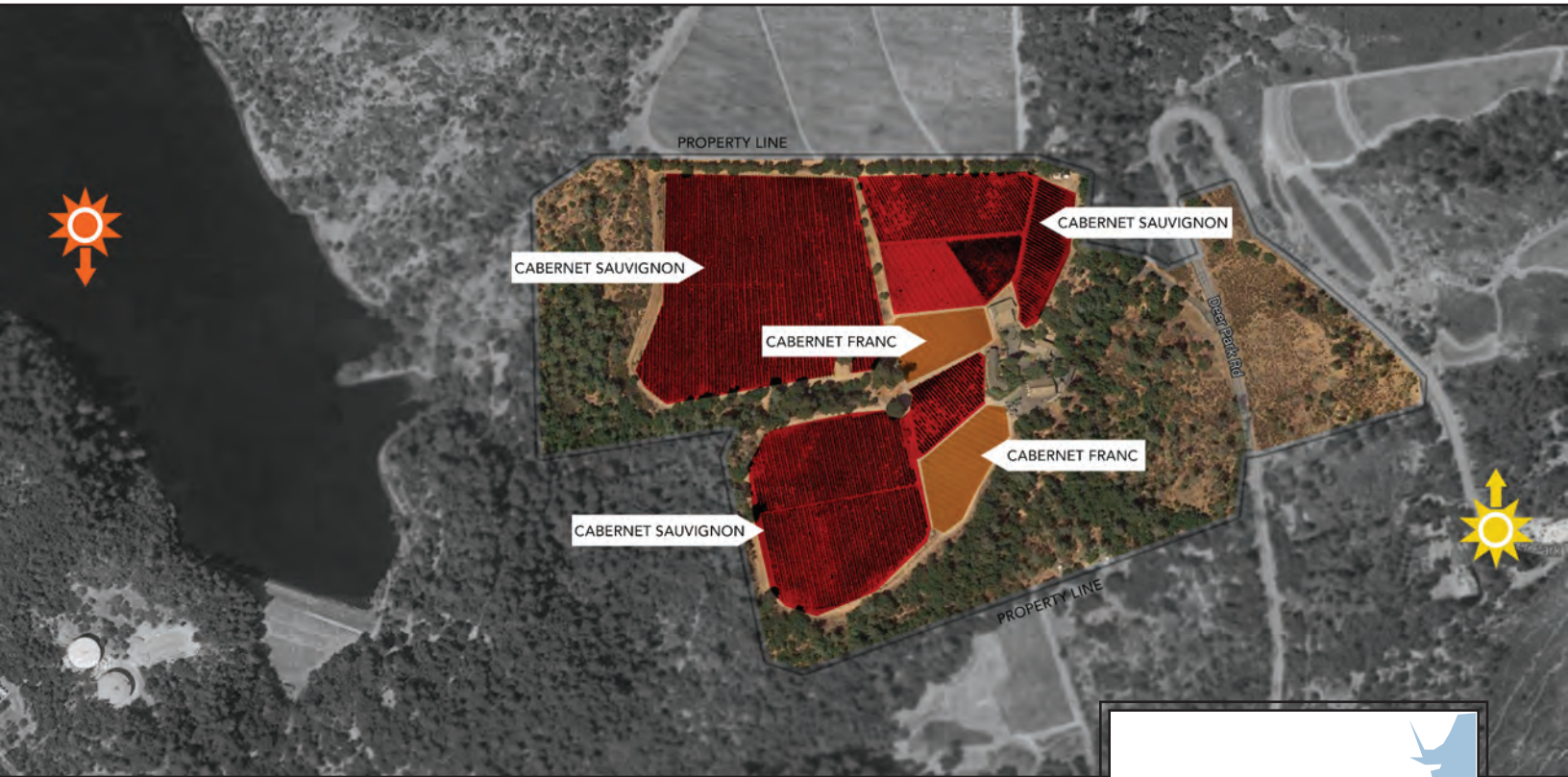




Burgess Estate Vineyards

GENERAL:

This vineyard, facing west from the side of Howell Mountain has a slope averaging 22%. The soil is called "Tuff" which is compressed volcanic ash. It drains very well allowing the grapes to achieve full maturity each year. The vineyard sits comfortably in the frost-free zone of Napa Valley creating a natural setting for the grapes. Hot days and cool nights mixed with the unique landscape provide a premium mountainous flavor to all our wines.
